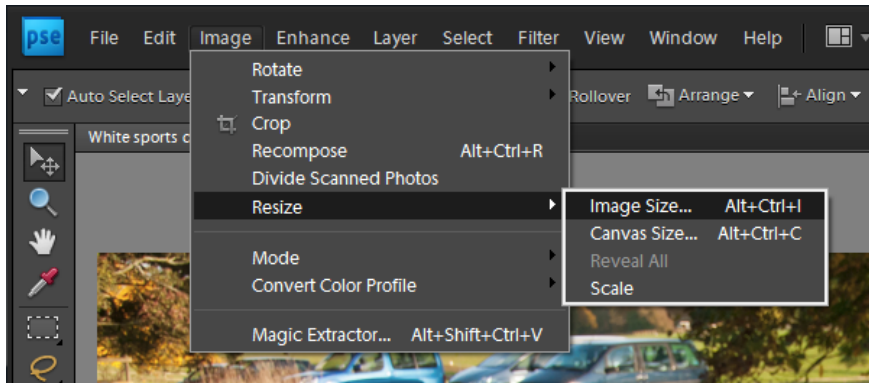
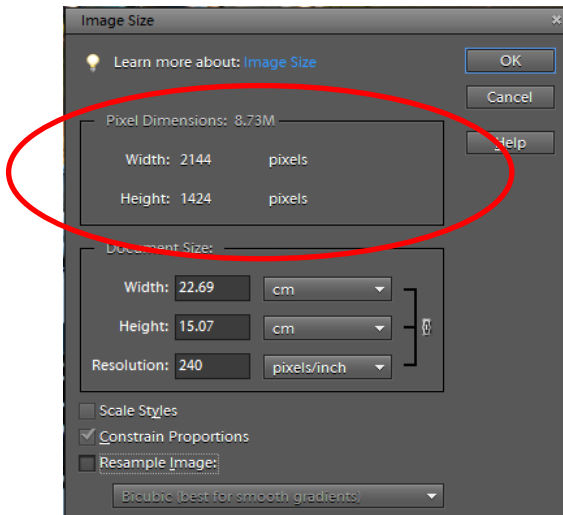


## Resizing an image in Elements 9

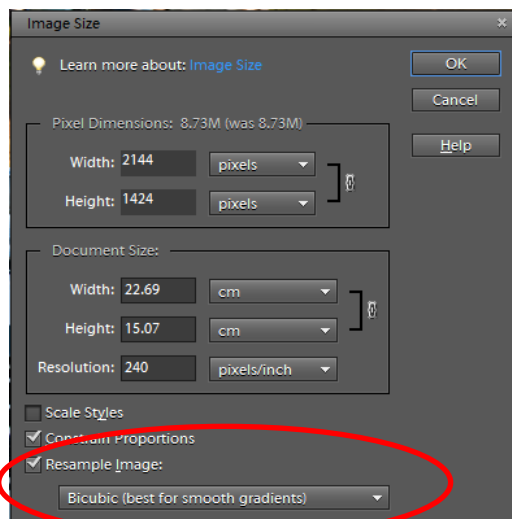
1. Open your image
2. From the Menu bar select Image > Resize > Image Size



3. When the Image Size dialogue box opens the Pixel Dimension box may be greyed out like this:

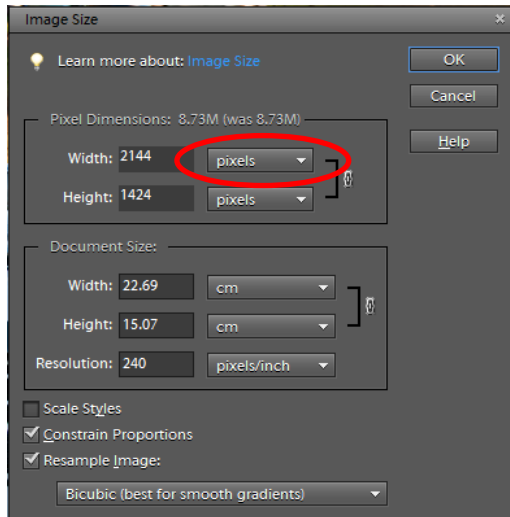


4. To allow you to edit the Pixel dimension you need to tick the Resample Image command at the bottom:



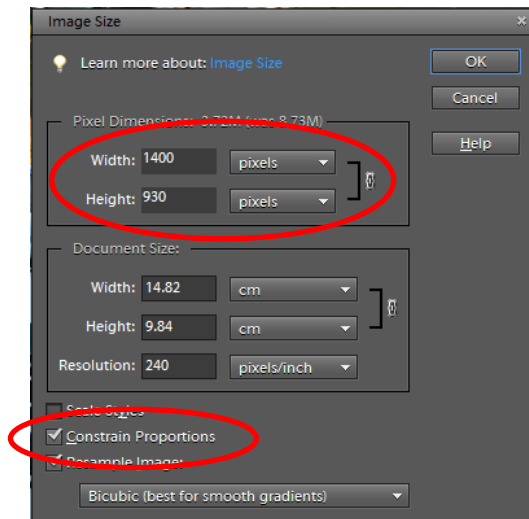
Leave the resampling method to Bicubic (best for smooth gradients)

5. Select pixels from the drop down menu:

6. For a landscape image type 1400 into the width dimension box.



Make sure that you have Constrain Proportions box ticked. This keeps the image proportioned correctly.

With this particular image the height has come under the required 1050px maximum. However, if the image height wasn't under 1050px you would follow the same procedure for the height. This would reduce the width to a dimension under 1400px but this is ok.
